## Free Summer Food Programs

Most VT and NH towns participate in a free healthy summer meal program once the school year has ended. If you are 18 years or younger you may go to a designated location for a free lunch meal. Some sites even offer a free meal to an accompanying adult! ## It's Fuel Assistance time!

During these Summer days you're probably not thinking about heating fuel. You are doing all that you can to keep cool. I am here to inform you it is time to think about your heating bill for this next season. L.I.H.E.A.P. (LOW Income Home Energy Assistance Program also known as Fuel Assistance, is open to apply now in VT and NH.

Anyone in VT can apply now. You may apply online or in person. **Click on this link for the online application: Vermont Fuel Assistance**

Between November 2019 and the end of April 2020 is when you can apply for the VT **Crisis Fuel** program. You must first apply for regular Fuel Assistance. The income guidelines are higher for the Crisis Fuel Program. Your Work United RC can give this information to you if you request it.

In NH they are currently taking applications for the most vulnerable of populations which include; children 5 and younger, those on disability and those age 60 and older. You must apply through your local CAA (Community Action Agency). Some applications are available online. **Click on this link to find your agency: NH Fuel Assistance**

Currently the income guidelines are set at 200% of the FPG but once our government releases NH's 60% of the SMI guidelines, the amount allowed in the household per month will go up significantly! Apply now! Your Work United RC can give you the income guidelines and support you through this process.

### Cheap Tire Sale

Vermont has a wonderful program that take place once a year in October. You can purchase DMV inspected new/used cheap tires! The program is called Wheels for Warmth. The money you spend on your tire purchase helps to keep homes in VT warmer during the cold months. You will not spend more than \$100 on a set of tires. \*Unless you purchase the larger tires. **Click on this link for more info: Wheels for Warmth**
