BRING IT!!! GOALS

- Offer a variety of programs that promote youth development and support cross-cultural understanding
- Involve the surrounding community to help families living in the neighborhoods of Manchester.

BRING IT!!! Serves

- Over 300 Manchester youth each school year
- Participants from over 20 countries, including students born right here in Manchester
- 15 different Manchester schools

Location and Times

Tuesday and Wednesday nights during the school year at Hillside Middle School

Programs Offered

- **Soccer** - students are grouped into both junior and senior division teams and play 6-8 week tournaments throughout the school year.
- **Dance** - students receive high-caliber instruction from professional instructors in hip hop as well as traditional cultural dance.
- **Academic Support** - students receive homework and academic support each night from local teachers and volunteers, including literacy support and enrichment through use of Reading Plus.
- **Nursing** - students attend the weekly program where they learn the basics of the field of nursing and receive training to become certified in First Aid and CPR.
- **Art** - students participate in a 10 week art class taught by NHIA students, covering a variety of mediums from clay, to painting, to felting.
- **STEM** - students participate weekly in science, technology, engineering, and math labs to help develop the future of Manchester's STEM workforce.
