KEEPING KIDS ON TRACK



- Providing education and support to over 300 parents, building strong, healthy families
- Supporting efforts to help over 350 kids be ready to learn when entering kindergarten
- Engaging nearly 400 youth in academically enriching out-of-school programs

FINANCIAL STABILITY



- Preparing free tax returns for over 300 households in the Central Region, bringing nearly \$500,000 back to our community in partnership with nine local employers
- Providing information and referral resources to nearly 2,600 local callers through 2-1-1 NH
- Supporting the community's current and future workforce through STEM opportunities, industry-specific education and internships, and employability training

COMMUNITY HEALTH



- Whole Village Family Resource Center is home to 13 nonprofit programs that help strengthen families in the region
- Addressing the dynamic healthcare needs of over 2,400 individuals who are uninsured or underinsured
- Leveraging over \$250,000 in prescription drug assistance to individuals in need of life-saving medications
- Empowering a network of partners to develop a plan to improve community health through Carroll County Coalition for Public Health
