Sarah has been working with New Beginnings for over two years. She first came to the shelter six-months pregnant after fleeing a violent relationship.

Fighting a losing custody battle of their six-year-old daughter, Sarah had no choice but to return to the abusive relationship to ensure her safety.

Almost a year later, Sarah returned to the shelter with both of her children. With the help of a New Beginnings advocate, Sarah was able to get court-ordered custody of both of her children.

Seeking a more financially stable life for her and her children, Sarah enrolled in the our matched savings program and saved a total of \$1,000 toward a new apartment.

After eight-months, Sarah and her advocate met with a local landlord to sign her first lease.
