UNITED is Responding In A Crisis.

During the COVID-19 pandemic Granite United Way and its network of agencies served as a community support, including:

- **\$4 Million distributed** to individuals, families, and small businesses to help mitigate the impact of the pandemic on our local communities
- **800,000+ vaccinated** in partnership with State of New Hampshire, National Guard, Public Health Networks and Providers
- **9,000 students received support** to help them learn remotely and promote their mental well-being while in isolation

UNITED is Ensuring Access to Literacy.

Creating positive educational experiences for caregivers and children to share is an important part of creating communities where books are center-stage.

Concord Reads is Granite United Way's innovative partnership with local nonprofits to support literacy throughout childhood. This year, this partnership will:

- **Launch "My First Book Club"** in partnership with Granite YMCA's Concord Branch, bringing additional literacy development projects to preschool students while adding to their home libraries.
- **Strengthen literacy education efforts** in Waypoint's home visiting program, supporting our caregivers as our students' "first teachers."
- **Enhance digital literacy efforts for New American students** and caregivers in partnership with Overcomers.
