## UNITED is Responding In A Crisis.

During the COVID-19 pandemic Granite United Way and its network of agencies served as a community support, including:

- **\$4 Million distributed** to individuals, families, and small businesses to help mitigate the impact of the pandemic on our local communities
- **800,000+ vaccinated** in partnership with State of New Hampshire, National Guard, Public Health Networks and Providers
- **9,000 students received support** to help them learn remotely and promote their mental well-being while in isolation

## UNITED is Rooting Out Hunger.

For a growing number of families in Northern New Hampshire, putting food on the table is a daily challenge. In the wake of the COVID-19 Pandemic, 1 in 5 households are food insecure. Yet New Hampshire residents struggle to access the nutrition programs available to them. Granite United Way is partnering with NH Legal Assistance and dozens of local nonprofits to change this pattern. Local nonprofits in partnership with NH Legal Assistance, will help families access the benefits they are eligible for, reducing financial pressure and improving financial stability across the region.
