Fuel Assistance VT/NH

Don't Wait until it's too late!

It is time to sign up for Fuel Assistance in **VT**. Anyone can sign up at this time. Click link -> **VT Fuel Assistance**

Its time time sign up for Fuel Assistance in **NH**. You will want to apply through your local Community Action Program (CAP). Click on this link to find your CAP -> **NH Fuel Assistance**

Program Application Dates

- Households with children under the age of 6, disabled and/or elderly or heat with wood (wood pellets) can start applying July 16th
- Households that heat with oil, kerosene, and propane can start applying September 1st
- Electric Heat and Heat included with the rent households can start applying October 15th
- All Applications- October 15
- Program Opens-December 1

If you are an Upper Valley resident or if you know of an Upper Valley resident that has a household with children under the age of 18 or over the age of 65 that reside in one of the following towns: **(NH)** Canaan, Dorchester, Enfield, Grafton, Grantham, Hanover/Etna, Lebanon/West Lebanon, Lyme/Lyme Center, Meriden/Plainfield, Orange, Orford, Springfield or **(VT)** Barnard, Bethel, Fairlee/West Fairlee, Hartford/West Hartford, Hartland/North Hartland, Norwich, Pomfret, Post Mills, Quechee, Royalton/South Royalton, Sharon, Strafford/South Strafford, Thetford/East Thetford, White River Junction, Wilder, Woodstock/South Woodstock. It is time to sign up for your holiday basket at Listen Services!

Applications start September 1, 2019 and end November 27, 2019. Call Listen to set up an appointment at 603-448-4553. If you are outside of Listen's service area they can give you your local information. Link here -> **Listen Holiday Baskets**
Listen's Holiday Basket program is based on income and household circumstances. If you think you might be over income but you have had some extenuating household circumstances do not hesitate to reach out to Listen.


Later this fall your Work United Resource Coordinator will be able to refer you to the Toys for Tots program. Your RC will let you know when it is time to sign up.
