Investing in the next generation is one of the key elements to building strong communities. Granite United Way investments in youth throughout the Southern Region continue to be some of our greatest impact across the community.

Programs like **Leader in Me** grew tremendously throughout the Manchester School District over the past five years. This is a result of a generous matching gift from the Stebbins Family, the program is now being offered in all five of the West Side schools from elementary to high school.

The Youth Enrichment Partnership continues to make strides in addressing the needs of the middle school-aged youth across the community. This effort involves more than a dozen youth-serving, local nonprofits combining forces to act on behalf of children.

In the Greater Derry area, investments have been made in adolescent wellness. At The Upper Room, nearly 500 youth have been supported by their Adolecent Wellness and Junenile Diversion programs. Many of which accessed other programs within the agency as well, or their families accessed services.
