### KEEPING KIDS ON TRACK

- Implement curriculum to develop leadership skills for over 1,000 elementary school students
- Engage 100 off-track readers to get back on track this school year

### FINANCIAL STABILITY



- Preparing free tax returns for over 1,100 households in the Southern Region, bringing over \$1 million back to our community
- Providing information and referral resources to 7,647 local callers through 2-1-1 NH
- Answering the immediate concerns related to food, shelter, and safety needs for nearly 7,000 residents in our community
