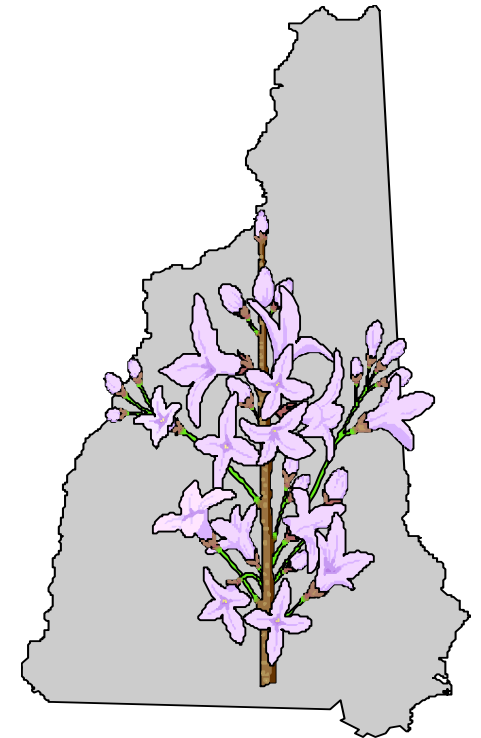

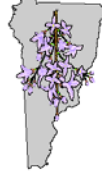


Speaker's Guide
