3,683 INDIVIDUALS, CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN THE FRANKLIN AREA WERE SERVED BY GRANITE UNITED WAY FUNDED PROGRAMS IN 2010.

1,521 low-income individuals with no insurance received discounted or free healthcare services through the Health First Family Care Center.

184 individuals participated in child abuse and early intervention programs through Parenting Plus at Child and Family Services.

460 at risk youth were matched with senior volunteers who provided tutoring and mentoring through the Foster Grandparent program at Friends.

109 elderly and disabled adults received transportation to life sustaining medical appointments and life enriching activities from the Rural Transportation program through the Merrimack- Belknap County CAP.

120 low-income individuals received basic legal services from private attorneys through NH Pro Bono.

WHAT WILL MY CONTRIBUTION DO IN MERRIMACK COUNTY?

A contribution of \$2 per week (\$104 per year) will provide meals to a family of four for ten days.

A contribution of \$5 per week (\$260 per year) enables two children to be members of the Pittsfield Youth Workshop for one year.

A contribution of \$10 per week (\$520 per year) would provide bus passes for 416 homeless individuals to get to necessary medical appointments.

A contribution of \$20 per week (\$1,040 per year*) provides a school in a disadvantaged area with six tutors for the entire school year.
