Granite United Way is committed to creating lasting change by addressing the underlying causes of our community's problems.

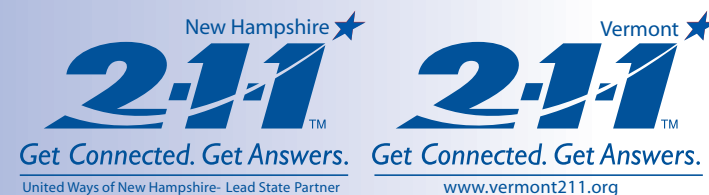
## WHAT WILL YOUR CONTRIBUTION DO?

- ⊙ A contribution of \$2 per week (\$104 per year) enables two children to be members of the Boys and Girls Club for one year.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$5 per week (\$260 per year) provides an older adult with transportation to necessary medical appointments twice per month.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$10 per week (\$520 per year) covers the cost of sending an emergency response vehicle to a disaster operation.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$20 per week (\$1,040 per year\*) provides a healthy and nutritious meal to three elderly, homebound or disabled individuals for a year.
