1,274 INDIVIDUALS, CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN THE PEMBROKE AREA WERE SERVED BY GRANITE UNITED WAY FUNDED PROGRAMS IN 2010.

214 seniors participated in programming to ensure their physical, emotional and economic well-being through Merrimack- Belknap County CAP Senior Centers.

144 individuals received emergency mental health services through Riverbend Community Mental Health.

170 elderly or homebound individuals received warm, nutritious meals through the Merrimack- Belknap County CAP Meals on Wheels program.

153 low-income individuals received basic legal services from private attorneys through NH Pro Bono.

WHAT WILL MY CONTRIBUTION DO IN MERRIMACK COUNTY?

A contribution of \$2 per week (\$104 per year) will provide meals to a family of four for ten days.

A contribution of \$5 per week (\$260 per year) enables two children to be members of the Pittsfield Youth Workshop for one year.

A contribution of \$10 per week (\$520 per year) would provide bus passes for 416 homeless individuals to get to necessary medical appointments.

A contribution of \$20 per week (\$1,040 per year*) provides a school in a disadvantaged area with six tutors for the entire school year.
