WHAT WILL YOUR CONTRIBUTION DO?

- ⊙ A contribution of \$2 per week (\$104 per year) enables two children to be members of the Boys and Girls Club for one year.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$5 per week (\$260 per year) provides two victims of domestic violence and their children with access to support services and a safe, non-threatening environment.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$10 per week (\$520 per year) provides five uninsured or underinsured individuals with four months of pharmaceutical refills to treat chronic conditions.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$20 per week (\$1,040 per year*) provides a healthy and nutritious meal to three elderly, homebound or disabled individuals for a year.
