IN 2010, THOUSANDS OF INDIVIDUALS, CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN SOUTHERN WINDSOR COUNTY WERE SERVED BY GRANITE UNITED WAY FUNDED PROGRAMS.

185 children from low to middle-income households received healthy lunches and snacks through the Nutrition program at Springfield Family Center in Southern Windsor County, VT.

199 adults and 152 children from distressed families received a full holiday meal through the Holiday Basket program at Black River Good Neighbor Services in Ludlow, VT.

1,916 low-income residents of Windham and Windsor Counties at risk of going without heat during the winter months were provided with emergency fuel assistance through the Emergency Fuel program at Southeastern Vermont Community Action in Southern Windsor County.

181 low-income uninsured adults in need of dental services were provided guidance about available services, scheduling and payment options for consultations, prevention, and treatment of dental disease through the Dental Case Management/ Access program at Precision Valley Free Clinic in Springfield, VT.

528 Hospice patients facing a life-limiting illness or injury were provided expert medical care, pain management, and emotional and spiritual support expressly tailored to the patient's needs and wishes through the Hospice program at Visiting Nurse Association and Hospice.

WHAT WILL MY CONTRIBUTION DO IN THE UPPER VALLEY AND SOUTHERN WINDSOR COUNTY REGIONS?

A contribution of \$2 per week (\$104 per year) provides diapers, wipes and rash cream for an infant's first month of life at Willow Grove.

A contribution of \$5 per week (\$260 per year) enables thirteen children to be members of the Boys and Girls Club for one year.

A contribution of \$10 per week (\$520 per year) provides specialized medical equipment for visiting nurses' medical bags.

A contribution of \$20 per week (\$1,040 per year*) provides 693 meals a year to individuals that perhaps would have gone hungry.
