WHAT WILL YOUR CONTRIBUTION DO?

- ⊙ A contribution of \$2 per week (\$104 per year) provides diapers, wipes and rash cream for an infant's first month of life at Willow Grove.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$5 per week (\$260 per year) enables thirteen children to be members of the Boys and Girls Club for one year.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$10 per week (\$520 per year) provides specialized medical equipment for visiting nurses' medical bags.
- ⊙ A contribution of \$20 per week (\$1,040 per year*) provides 693 meals a year to individuals that otherwise may have gone hungry.
