Some examples of how we are helping people **Learn, Earn and Be Healthy** in the Central Region



Learn

Over 300 children from low income families gained access to high-quality childcare, helping them prepare for kindergarten success.

770+ young people engaged in enriching afterschool and summer programming, supporting their academic and social development.



Earn

660+ households utilized free tax preparation services in the Central Region, bringing nearly \$900,000 in federal tax refunds to the community.

Over 5,600 211 NH callers from the Central Region received referrals to social services, including to homelessness, legal supports, and utility assistance.



Be Healthy

Carroll County Coalition for Public Health (C3PH) provided **700+ influenza vaccines** at 15 schools through school-based clinics throughout Carroll County.

Central Region residents saved over \$230,000 on prescriptions through Granite United Way's partnership with the FamilyWize discount prescription program.
