MERRIMACK COUNTY HIGHLIGHT: AMPLIFYING STUDENT VOICES ACROSS THE REGION

Collaborating in new ways is the key to addressing complex community issues. A great example of this is the partnership between Granite United Way and Media Power Youth when they were able to expand their hands-on technology learning program's success to the Greater Concord area.

With the support of Granite United Way, Media Power Youth created a new media mentoring program in Concord that explored behaviors contributing to mental health, the role of relationships, and the different ways people stay healthy and happy. Participants put their learning into action by creating videos and musical play lists to inspire others. Leadership training offered skills on engaging youth in conversations about social media, its affects on mental health, and setting personal boundaries. After consulting with schools on how to improve school climate, programs focused on cyberbullying. Future collaborations include working with partners on a statewide bullying prevention project and additional programs with the New Hampshire Audubon and the Friends Program in Concord.
