Some examples of how we are helping people **Learn, Earn and Be Healthy** in the North Country



Learn

Enriching summer programming is available to young people, supporting academic and social development.

Nearly 180 young people are learning skills to improve teamwork, leadership skills and self-esteem through after-school programming.



Earn

Over 130 households utilized free tax preparation services, bringing over \$160,000 in federal tax refunds to the community.

Nearly 800 211 NH callers from the North Country received critical referrals to social services, including needs related to homelessness, legal supports, and utility assistance.



Be Healthy

Over 3,100 older adults accessed programming that improved physical and mental health and social connectedness.

North Country residents saved over \$25,000 on prescriptions through Granite United Way's partnership with the FamilyWize discount program.
