NORTHERN REGION HIGHLIGHT: BUILDING HEALTHY FAMILIES IN THE NORTHERN REGION

Collaborating in new ways is the key to addressing complex community issues.

A great example of this is the partnership between Granite United Way and The Family Resource Cente (FRC)r at Gorham. Both organizations are committed to building strong families across the region. Throughout the past year, The Family Resource Center has served nearly 1,500 individuals needing support through programs that offer parenting supports, family reunification, and those assisting grandparents.

Stories like Sarah's are how the center can help ahead of any familial crisis. Sarah was a prenatal mom, new to the area, who felt she needed help in preparing for the baby. Sarah, who did not have family close by to offer support, was referred to the Family Resource Center by her pediatrician who had some concerns and felt she could benefit from additional resources. Together, with her Family Support Specialist, she developed a goal plan and remained engaged throughout her pregnancy, achieving each of those goals. Since then, she continues to refer other mothers for voluntary services at FRC that were seeking supports and resources for their child's healthy development.
