

Grant Review Volunteers Needed: Upper Valley

Grant review volunteers help Granite United Way's Upper Valley Region to meet the needs of our community. Teams of individuals from across our region come together to review and assess grant proposals, making funding recommendations to advance the common good throughout the Upper Valley.

Volunteer Duties:

- Attend an introductory session to learn about the review process and the needs in the Upper Valley.
- Individually review and assess grant proposals in identified focus area (about 10 hours)
- Meet as a team about 6-8 times during March and April to interview applicants, discuss proposals with other volunteers, and develop recommendations for funding (about 20 hours)
- Review teams meet on a variety of schedules based on reviewer availability, including days and evenings.
