Children's Literacy Foundation Grant

We received a CLiF literacy grant and partnered with Pease Public Library in Plymouth, to allow for more attendees. Marv Klassen-Landis, an author and Storyteller, engaged a group of 25 children and caregivers. The children were so excited to choose two free books, they could hardly wait to read. Whole Village reinforces literacy at our Playgroup and Family Fun Nights to demonstrate how reading and engaging children with books sets them up for later academic success. We shared books with our Head Start Program and others who have visited the Village. We have enhanced our library and that at Pease to expose everyone to new literature.
